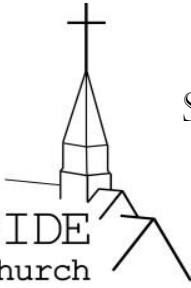

Wednesday Night Prayer Meeting 7 p.m: a study of the book "A Praying Life" to learn how to pray more fruitfully

Sunday School at 9:30 for all ages:

- Adult Classes:
 - Family Track: 14 Gospel Principles That Can Radically Change Your Family by Paul Tripp.
 - Large Group Bible Study: "That the World May Know" by Ray VanderLaan- each lesson begins with a DVD presentation of Biblical sites in Israel and then gives a "faith lesson for today" that we will discuss.
 - Small Group Bible Study: verse by verse discussion through the Gospel of Mark with historical insights.
- Teens and Children Classes- each Sunday at 9:30 children are divided by age groups and exposed to lessons from the Desiring God curriculum.
- Nursery for babies and Toddlers
